

COLOURED CONCRETE

All manufactured products derived from naturally occurring sources have differences in colour that are inherent to their varying physical properties. As such, whether it is granite, marble, slate, tile, aggregate or concrete there can be differences “batch to batch” in a given product manufactured from raw materials derived from nature.

In addition to naturally occurring raw material variations, concrete colour tone is affected by a myriad of factors beyond the control of the concrete producer. Specifically, some factors which can impact the in-place finished concrete colour tone are; the addition of water (adjusting the water-cement ratio), curing/bleeding rate (affected by temperature, sun, wind & age of concrete), placing and finishing technique (the amount of trowel ling applied to the surface of concrete), type of form release agent.

Due to the above factors, the exact in-place finished colour of a given batch of concrete cannot be guaranteed.

Rempel Bros. Concrete Ltd. does guarantee that the correct dosage of colour is added to a given mix, and will also guarantee that all Rempel Bros. Concrete Ltd. supplied concrete meets CSA performance specifications and the given strength requirements of the mix provided.

It is highly recommended that a concrete cure and seal is applied to freshly finished concrete to protect from UV rays and weathering that will occur if concrete is not properly cured, sealed and maintained.
